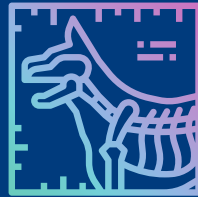

X-RAY SERVICES ARE COMING!

We continually strive to broaden our abilities to serve our clients and increase the services we offer. Thanks to an amazing donor we are thrilled to announce that we will soon have our very own x-ray machine!

This means so much to us! Not only will we be able to diagnose more injuries in house but our non profit will save a ton of costs by not having to outsource radiographs for our own injured rescued pets. We are in the process of researching which company offers the best model for our needs. We hope to have a decision made by the end of February and our new equipment installed by mid March.
